ELIGIBILITY

- is enrolled full-time, either as a high school senior or a college student at the undergraduate level
- has declared any chosen area of educational focus
- has a 3.0 minimum grade point average at the time of application (include transcripts or official record).

SELECTION PROCESS

Recipients will be selected by the Awards and Recognition Industry Educational Foundation trustees based on application materials provided.

All scholarship applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in February 2025. Payment will be made to the recipient's school of choice upon notification and in accordance with the school's scholarship guidelines. Recipients will be announced at the International Personalization Expo on February 4–7, 2025.
